

## **OBEX™** Rolls Installation Guidelines

## **General**

OBEX™ Rolls come with an impervious vinyl backing.

## Bonding of OBEX™ Rolls to the Subfloor

If installation requires that several rolls are fitted next to each other - make sure that the rolls have all been manufactured from the same dye lot.

## A. Preparation work:

- 1. Check measurements
- 2. Ensure subfloor is level, sound and free of contaminants such as grease. If greasy, clean with degreaser and prime if necessary.
- 3. Apply adhesive and allow drying. See recommended adhesives on the below chart:

For optimum stability through the lifetime of the installation it is recommended to use a permanent adhesive. When fitting product on stairs, and when installing rolls side by side, a permanent adhesive must be used for seams to secure durable bond on these specific areas.

- 4. Lay material ensuring that pile direction is consistent throughout and that any joins are overlapped, and the patterns aligns.
- 5. Cut off all excess material using a sharp knife and straight edge.
- 6. Use roller over the textile to ensure good bonding.

If there is any evidence of pile crushing in transit or storage, renovate pile using a vacuum cleaner with rotary brush.
